- Improved patient safety
- Empowerment of other professional groups

Method

The study were conducted at the Rehabilitation in Hilleroed Municipality. The department holds 30 temporary 24 hours beds. Patients are mainly received from hospital admissions.

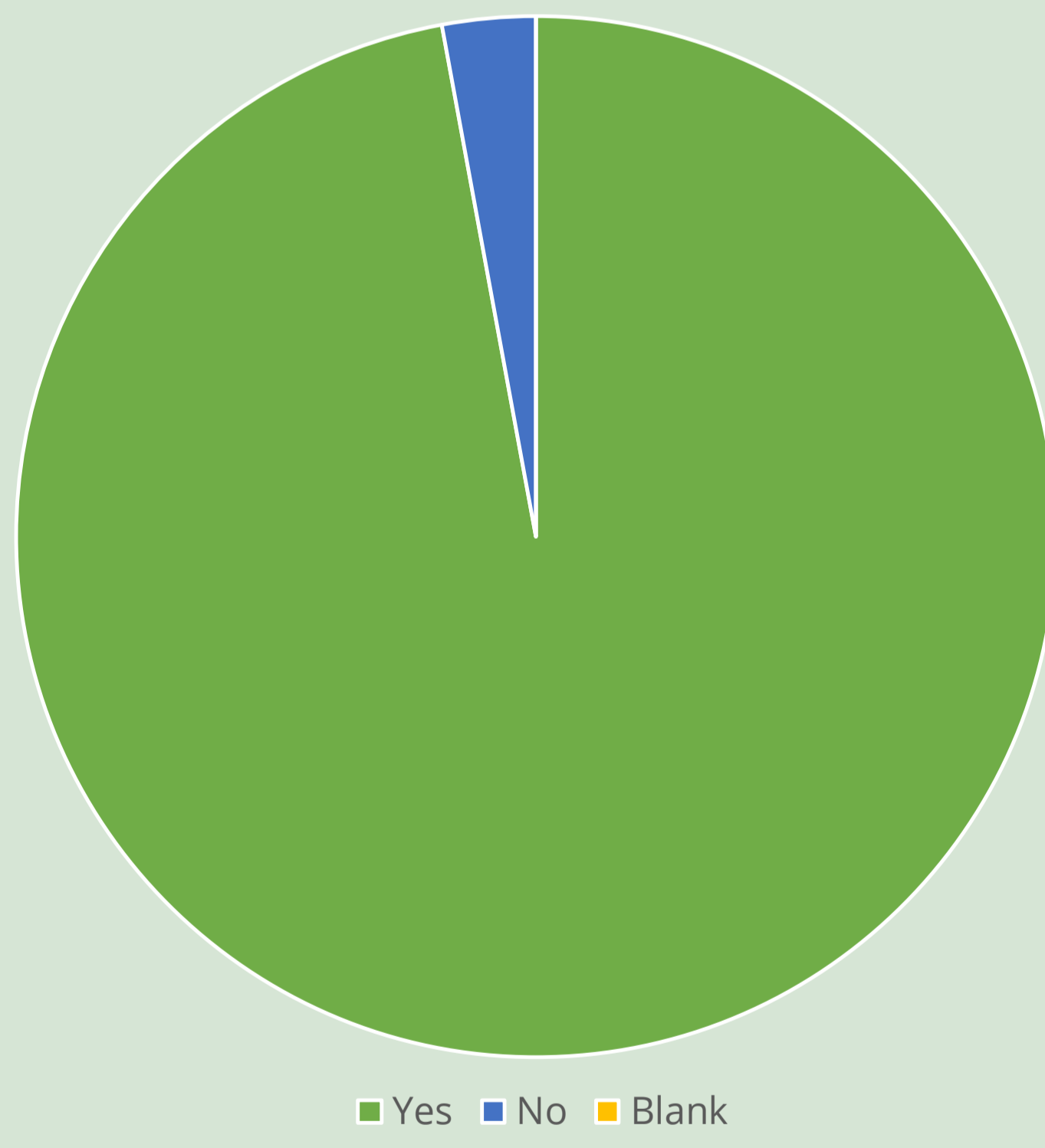
Data is collected via electronic questionnaires, with 9 questions based on subjective assessment of the impact on patient safety, released extra time and empowerment of own work.

Available data was conducted over a 6-month period. Data was collected, from staff working in rehabilitation. The Survey was a total of 42 persons, with 34 valid answers.

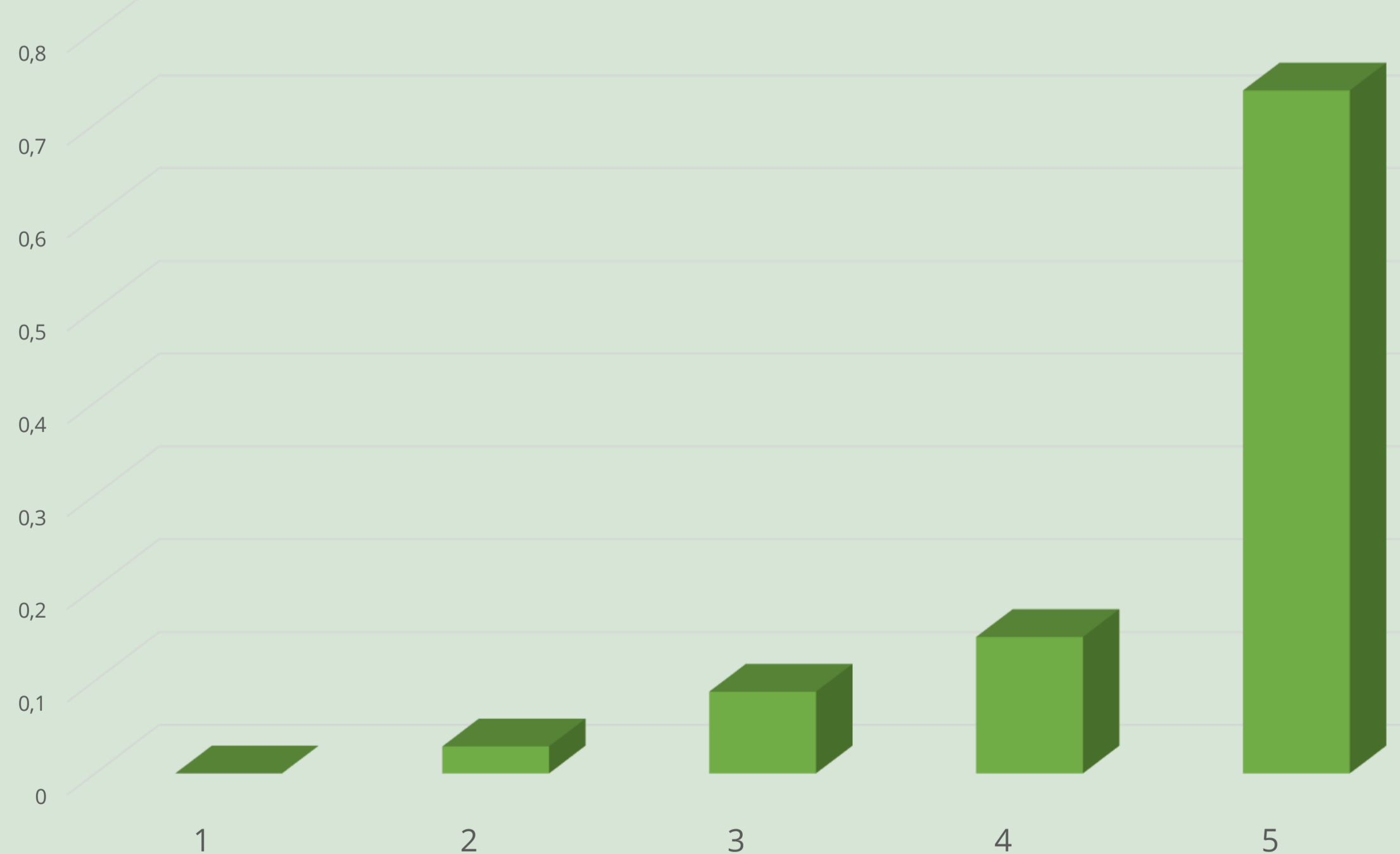


Results

Pharmaconomist's Impact on patient safety

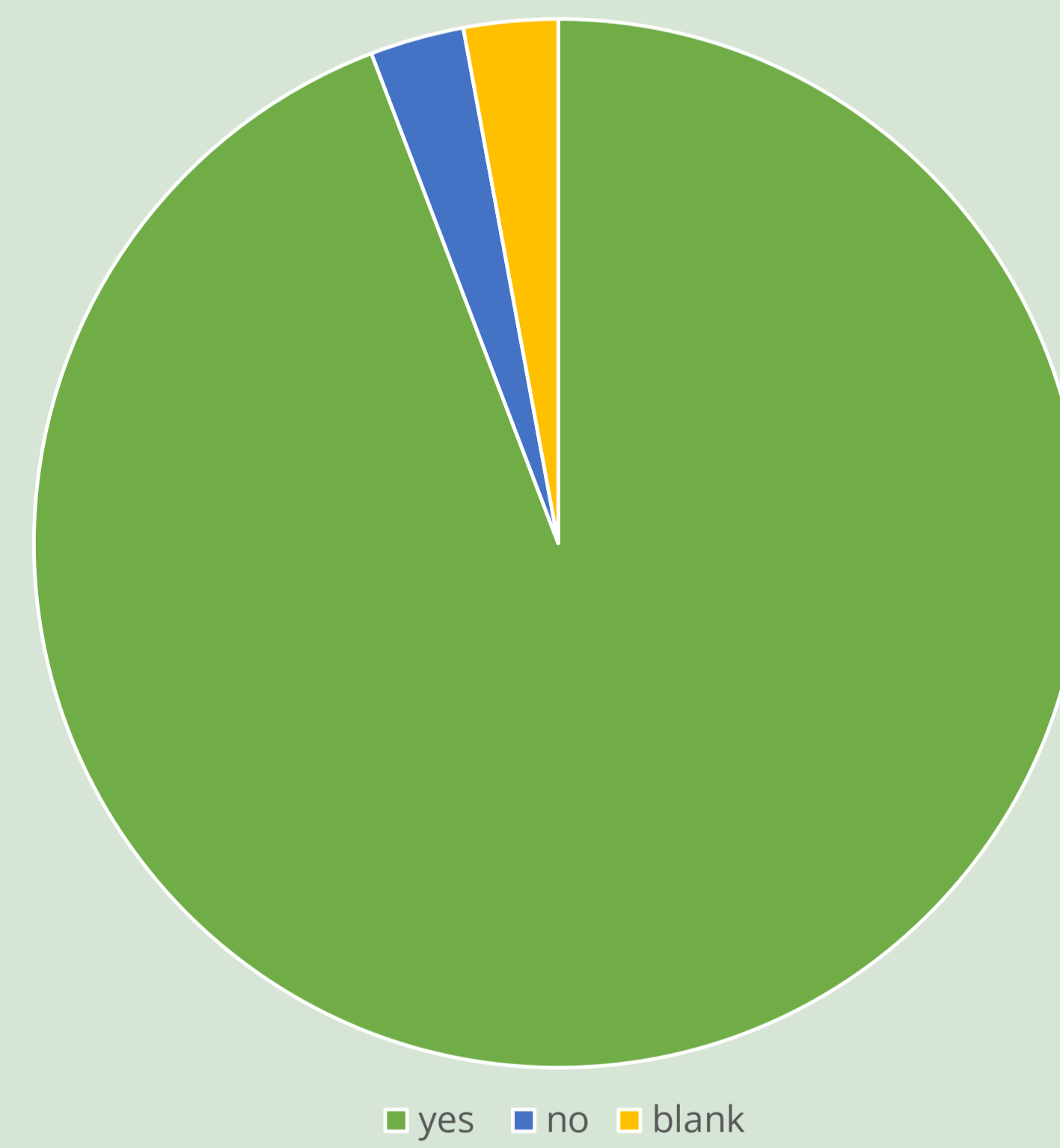


Mesured impact on patient safety on 1 to 5

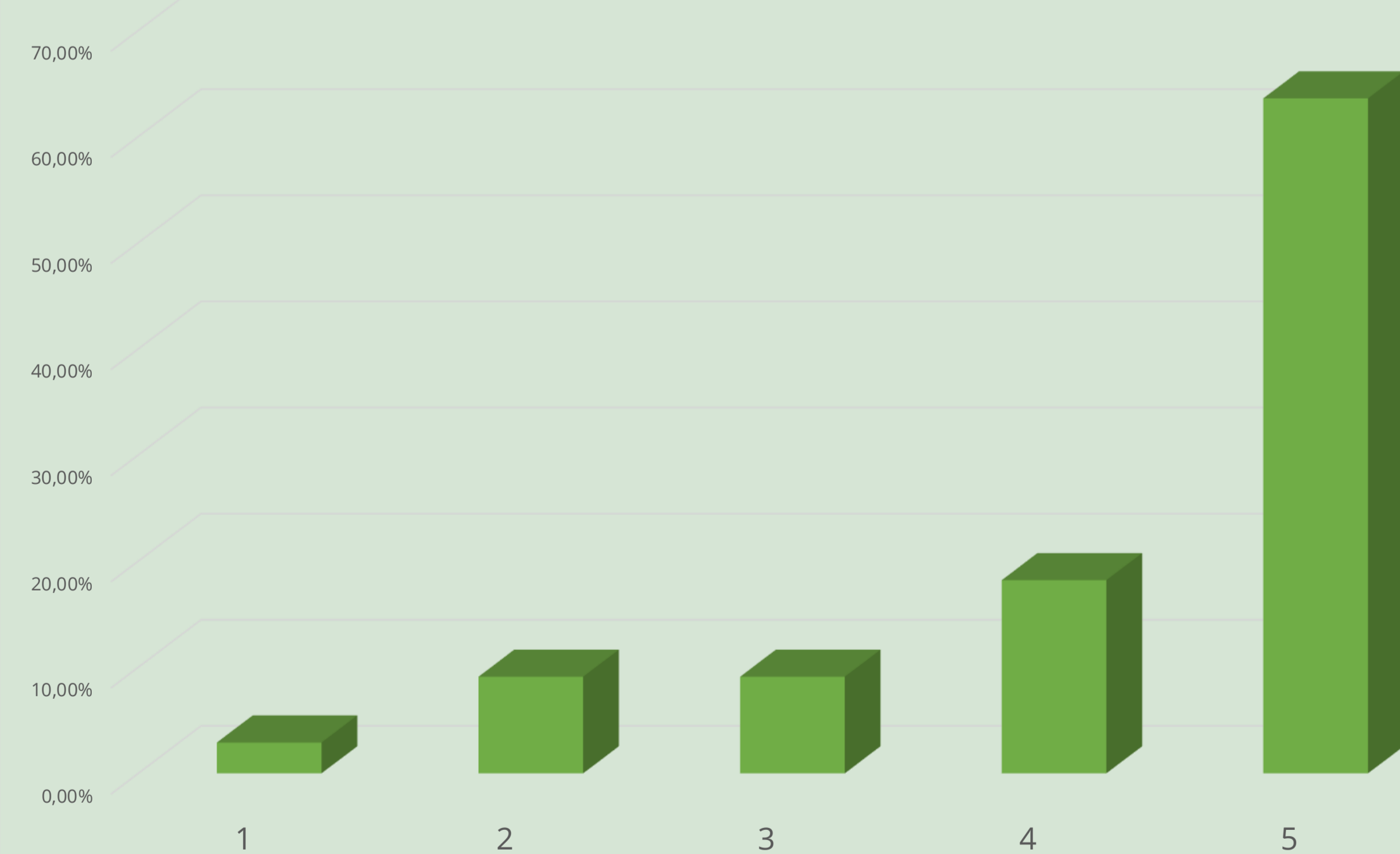


In overall 97,06 % evaluated, that the Pharmaconomist had a positive effect on patient safety. On a scale from 1-5, weighted average was 4,59 on improved patient safety.

Pharmaconomist empowerment of other professionals



Mesured impact on a scale from 1-5



94,12 % answered, that a Pharmaconomist empowered their own work. On a scale from 1-5, average was 4,36 on strengthening of own work

Conclusion

Over a short period of time, a clear picture is seen with significant results in relation to increased patient safety and contributions to strengthening other professional groups

Pharmaconomists' contribution in interdisciplinary work, shows from the survey a significant positive effect on patient safety, empowering of other professional staff and released extra time.
